Last week, the TCU Board of Trustees met for their annual fall Board meetings. To support sustainability and initiatives to enhance TCU's academic and student experience, the Board approved a 4.75% tuition rate increase for the 2026-2027 academic year.

The Board reaffirmed its commitment to ensuring that TCU remains accessible to all academically talented and qualified students through merit-based scholarships and financial aid. Need-based aid will increase by 4.75% to match student and family need. The Neeley School of Business Differential Tuition will also increase by 4.75%, in line with the TCU tuition rate increase. The Anne Burnett Marion School of Medicine at TCU tuition rate will increase by 4.75% as well.

The Board emphasized its dedication to responsible financial stewardship and expressed a strong desire to continue moderating tuition increases, despite the rise in operational costs.
