




# From the Desk of the **CHANCELLOR**

- **Campus Improvements:** From the east side of campus to Worth Hills and along Berry Street, construction is in full swing on a new [parking garage](#) and new residence halls with 2,450 beds (anticipated occupancy Fall 2027). Please stay alert to changing pedestrian and vehicle traffic patterns throughout the construction process. [Market Square dining in the Brown-Lupton University Union \(BLUU\) is currently closed for renovations](#) and is scheduled to reopen in Fall 2026.
