



# Medical History/Immunizations

Pursuant to Senate Bill 1107, all entering (new and transfer) students, as well as re-enrolling following a fall or spring semester break in enrollment from TCU, must show evidence of having been vaccinated against bacterial meningitis within the five-year period preceding the first day of the semester in which the student is currently enrolling or re-enrolling AND at least 10 days prior to moving into campus housing.

Evidence of vaccination must be submitted on the **Mandatory Bacterial Meningitis Vaccination Form**

This requirement DOES NOT pertain to:

- Students who are only enrolled in online courses or other distance education courses
- Students who are 22 years of age or older
- Students who are only enrolled in Extended Education courses

All new students must submit a completed Medical History Form and an official immunization record to the TCU Health Center. **In addition** to the Meningitis Requirements, immunization records must reflect immunizations for Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR).
